

## **ISA Karnataka Private Practitioners Session**

### **Aim**

- To provide platform for discussing issues and solutions relevant to freelance practice and private practitioners

### **Background**

- Private Practitioners provide Anaesthesia, Critical Care and Pain services in small/medium sized private, non-corporate, non-teaching Hospitals and Nursing homes, contributing to a major chunk of the workload of Anaesthesia fraternity.
- Unlike their counterparts in the Teaching/Corporate Hospitals who have facilities to work as per set standards and are exposed to academic events as speakers, Private Practitioners work in constrained work areas with certain limitations and do not have a forum to discuss and project their concepts and problems.
- The ISACON Karnataka Ballari Organizing Committee in 2017 provided platform for the first time to Private Practitioners of ISA to discuss and share day-to-day problems of private practice and improve the speciality for common good of patients and the speciality.
- The EC and GB of ISA Karnataka at Ballari in 2017 approved this programme for conducting at all future ISACON Karnataka conferences.
